Мирослав Филип (*чеш.* *Miroslav Filip*; [27 ноября 1928](#), [Прага](#) – [27 апреля 2009](#), там же) – чешский [шахматист](#), [гроссмейстер \(1955\)](#). Чемпион Чехословакии по шахматам в [1950](#), [1952](#) и [1954](#) годах.^[1]Участник турниров претендентов чемпионата мира 1956 и 1962.

С [1980 года](#) Мирослав Филип ушёл из профессиональных шахмат, но продолжал заниматься активной деятельностью в сфере шахматной журналистики.



Работал шахматным журналистом, вёл шахматные передачи на Чехословацком телевидении. Автор книг на чешском языке «Турнир претендентов 1956» (1957), «100 дней в Багуйо» (1979) и «Весь мир у них учится» (1980).

звание международного мастера ФИДЕ, Всемирной шахматной Федерации, в 1953 году. Свое растущее мастерство уже стало понятно из его побед в чешских национальных чемпионатах 1950 и 1953.

Это было за семь лет с 1955 по 1962 год, что Филип, в шесть футов девять дюймов в высоту внушительное присутствие на шахматной доске, поистине стала мировой силой. В этот период он дважды достигали заведомо трудный подвиг квалификации для кандидатов турниры к Чемпионату мира, в Амстердаме 1956 и снова в Кюрасао, 1962. Таким образом, Филипп был автоматически ворвался в верхние эшелоны мировой элиты. Именно в это счастливое время, которое Филип нанес поражение не менее трех чемпионов мира Доктор Макс Эйве в 1955 году Василий смыслов (Чемпион) в 1957 году и экс-чемпион мира Михаил Таль в 1962 году.

Филип также выиграл международные турниры в своем родном городе Праге в 1956, 1960 и снова в Мариенбаде Буэнос-Айрес, 1961. Не смотря на его сверкающие достижений и побед против лучших в мире в отдельных встречах, Филип провалился в его амбиция, чтобы сразиться за звание чемпиона мира. Действительно, в его второе появление в турнире претендентов на Кюрасао 1962, несмотря на выигрыш штраф контратакующих победу над Михаилом Талем, он был вообще деклассировал, как установлено советских гроссмейстеров и новая сила в лице Бобби Фишер, подвижный молодой американец. Therafter, Филип вырос меньше энтузиазма в турнире играть, все больше заботит избегая разгрома, на который он был адептом, чем в выигрыше выигрывает. В результате он повернул руку профессионала никогда больше авторства, журналистики и arbiting.

Он был выбран Всемирной шахматной Федерацией с просьбой быть арбитром в течение шести последующих чемпионских боев, включая спорные с V Карпов Корчной матч в Багио 1978. Он вел шахматную колонку в Праге ежедневная спортивная бумаге "Denik спорт" с великой честью, и написал книги о турнире претендентов 1956 года, чемпионата мира 1978 года и шахматной Олимпиаде в Люцерне в 1982 году.

Его мастерство как игрок в дальнейшем было подтверждено его результаты для Чехословакии в шахматных олимпиад , где он представлял свою страну на двенадцать замечательных случаев, три из тех, на верхней доске, забив 114 очков из 194 игры для 58.76 процент. В 1970 году он выиграл личную золотую медаль за свое выступление в Капфенберге командный Чемпионат Европы.

Мирослав Филип был достойным преемником традиции Пражской школы, которая насчитывала среди своих выпускников Вильгельм Стейниц, первый "официальный" чемпион мира, Рихард Рети, в pioneer из hypermodernism и Олдржих Дурас , великий турнир конкурента. Филип родился в Праге 27 октября 1928 г., умер там же 27 апреля, 2009.
