Пауль Ионер (нем. *Paul Johner*, 10 сентября 1887, Цюрих – 10 сентября 1938, Берлин) – вместе со своим братом Хансом, сильнейшие швейцарские шахматисты в 1-й половине XX века. Музыкант. 6-кратный чемпион страны (1908–1932), в том числе в 1908, 1928, 1932 совместно с братом Хансом. Лучшие результаты в международных турнирах: Копенгаген (1916 и 1924) – 1-е и 2-е; Берлин (1917) – 1-2-е; Гётеборг (1920, турнир «Б») и Триест (1923) – 1-е; Схевенинген (1923) – 1-2-е; Берлин (1924) – 1-е; Дебрецен (1925) – 2-3-е; Дортмунд (1928) – 3-е; Берн – 7-8-е места.



Paul F. Johner was born in Zürich. A noted musician, he was Nordic Champion in 1916 and won the Swiss Championship in 1907 (joint), 1908 (joint), 1925, 1928 (joint), 1930 and 1932 (joint). However, his most notable victory came in Berlin in 1924, when he won a four-way round robin ahead of [Akiba Rubinstein](#), [Richard Teichmann](#), and [Jacques Mieses](#). Older brother of [Hans Johner](#). He won the Manhattan Chess Club championship in 1907. He passed away in Berlin, Germany in 1938.

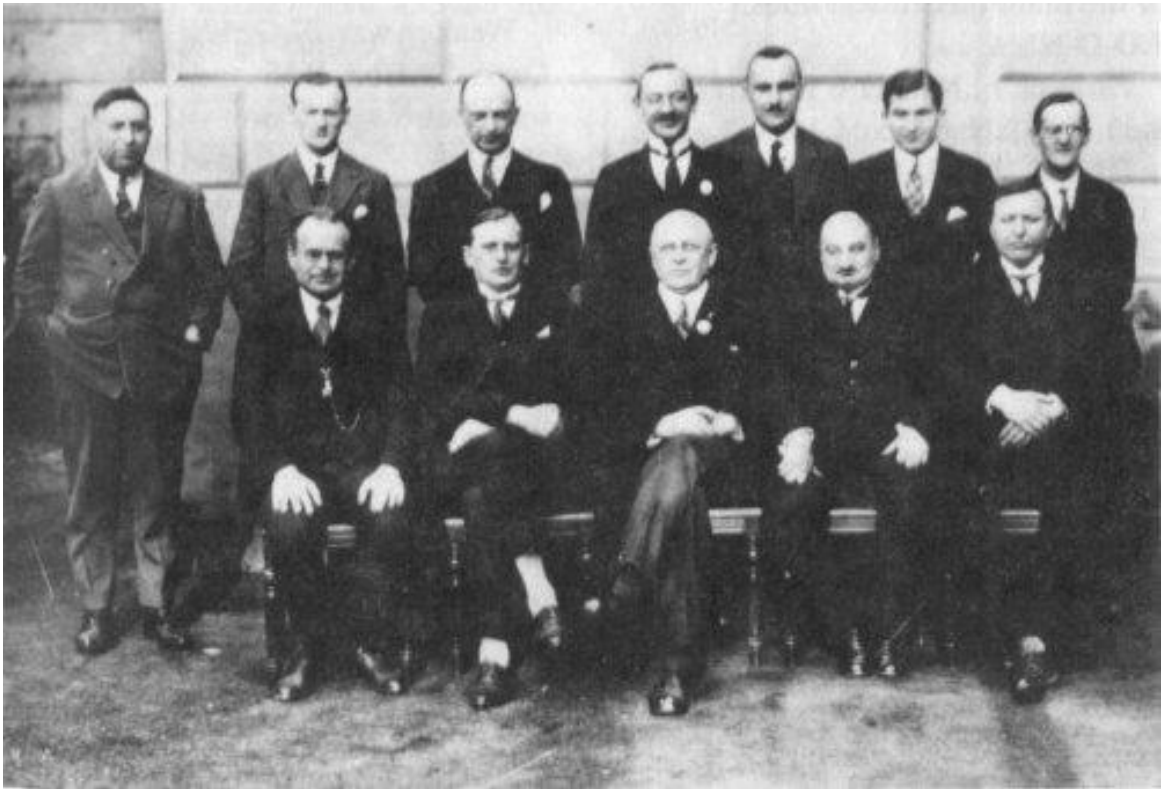

## DRESDEN 1926

A big chess event was organised in Dresden from 4 until 14 iv 1926. The fiftieth anniversary of the local chess club was celebrated! Main contest was a master tournament, called the *Paul Schellenberg Memorial*. It became a race between the world championship's candidates Nimzowitsch and Alekhine. Aaron triumphed. Some of his wins became classics. Rubinstein competed in the race until he was beaten by the top two. The fifth prize was won by the problem composer Von Holzhausen. We follow the games by Nimzowitsch and Alekhine.



Johner - Nimzowitsch (round two) Black played 33. ... Bxh3!

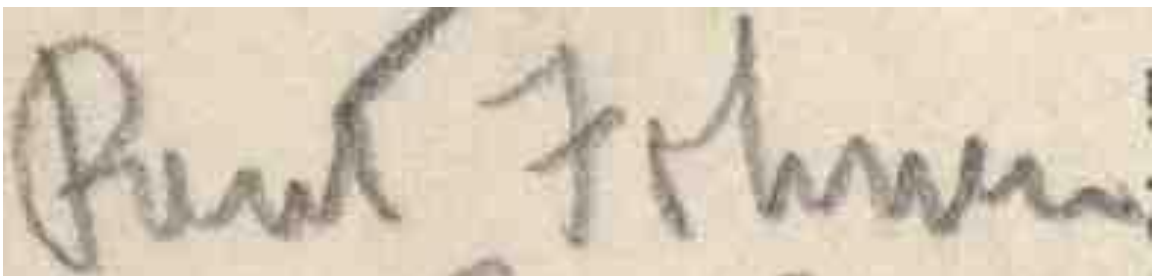


Standing: Rubinstein, Sämisch, Tartakower, organiser, Blümisch, Steiner, Yates
