



Ugge Alexander (Canada) He is an ICCF GM. He came clear 2nd in the 21st World Correspondence chess final. He lives in Keswick, Ontario, Canada. Won 22nd World Correspondence Championship Candidates tournament, Section 1, with undefeated 8.5/12 (+5 =7), 2003-6 2nd place, 21st World Correspondence Championship Final, with undefeated 8.5/14 (+3 =11), 2005-8 Ugge claims that as he was age 68 when the tournament started, he is the oldest player in the history of chess to win a medal in a World Championship. **Senior International Master.** Winner 21.World Championship Semifinal 3 (10,5/14) 1st place Bd.2 4.Panamerican Team Championship (7/9).
